

ENERGY POLICY

Rangemaster has produced this Energy Policy to formalise its commitment to energy efficiency and conservation. The purpose of this policy, which has been endorsed by the Managing Director, is to:

- *Promote the efficient use of energy;*
- *Minimise our energy and water consumption costs;*
- *Minimising energy waste and to promote reducing, recovery and recycling;*
- *Protect the environment by limiting the emission of Greenhouse Gases and prolonging the useful life of fossil fuels.*

Corporate Policy Statement

Rangemaster will endeavour to optimise energy consumption and eliminate waste without adversely affecting production and the working conditions of personnel.

Long Term Corporate Goals

The Long Term Corporate Goals of Rangemaster are to:

- Use all fuels and energy as efficiently as possible;
- Increase staff awareness in energy conservation and efficiency;
- Set targets and regularly monitor energy performance levels;
- Develop a programme of energy saving measures, which will maximise return on investment.

Medium Term Objectives

The Medium Term Objectives with respect to Energy Management and the implementation of the energy policy are:

- To establish The Energy Steering Group in order to promote energy conservation issues.
- The Energy Manager will be responsible for energy use in the facility and for the implementation of the energy policy;
- To ensure appropriate methods of communication whereby the energy policy and the energy procedures are understood and that management commitment to them is visible;
- To provide training for Managers and the Workforce as appropriate;
- Regularly review tariffs and negotiate competitive energy supply contracts.

Responsibilities

The Energy Steering Group will have overall responsibility for implementing the Energy Management Programme.

Monitoring and Targeting

Rangemaster will use the Energy Steering Group meetings to monitor progress and targeting.

Reporting

Rangemaster will display energy use on the intranet with progress against energy projects.

Review

Rangemaster will carry out regular reviews through the Energy Steering Group meetings. The reviews shall include:

- Consideration of the energy policy (aims, objectives, scope and adequacy)
- Comparisons of quantitative performance against targets
- Reviews of the implementation of energy efficiency improvements.

Rangemaster will aim to continually improve, and where appropriate to take into account the results of previous reviews.
